HISTORY OF THE KENTÉ CLOTH

WHAT IS KENTÉ CLOTH?

Kenté is an Asante ceremonial hand-woven cloth. Historical accounts trace its origin to the early weaving traditions of West African Kingdoms between 300 A.D. and 1600 A.D. Kenté as we know it today, was developed in the country of Ghana during the 12th century A.D. It received its name from the term "kenten", which means "basket", because of the cloth's resemblance to the woven design of a basket. Kings, Queens, and important figures of state in Ghanaian society wore the cloth during ceremonial events and special occasions.

Like most of Africa's visual art forms, Kenté is a visual representative of history, oral literature, religious belief, social values, and political thought. Kenté is reserved for very important social or religious occasions and is not meant to be used for commonplace activity, or ordinary wear. Today, as those of the African Diaspora gain a renewed sense of pride for their motherland, they wear the Kenté cloth for inspiration and as a reflection of the connection to their African ancestors.

WHAT IS THE DONNING OF THE KENTE?

Donning of the Kenté is a ceremony to commemorate the transition of graduates of African descent, Africans, African

Americans, Caribbean and Pacific Islanders, from one historical moment in their lives to the next.

At Peralta Colleges (College of Alameda, Berkeley City College, Laney College, and Merritt College), the Donning of the Kenté is the Rite of Passage for those persons who have taken the journey through their educational programs and are now graduating to the next leg of their life's journey where service and scholarship merge for the glory of God, and the liberating healing of our various communities.

It was for this day that your ancestors rejoiced to see your birth, because they believed that you were the one of promise; the one who would move your family's legacy forward and closer to their vision of a prosperous future. May all of your family's hopes for a bright future be mingled with yours and completely realized because you are a graduate of the Peralta Community College District. Together, with the ancestors we rejoice at this great accomplishment by exclaiming . . .

"Nyame meda wo ase!" "Thank You God!"
