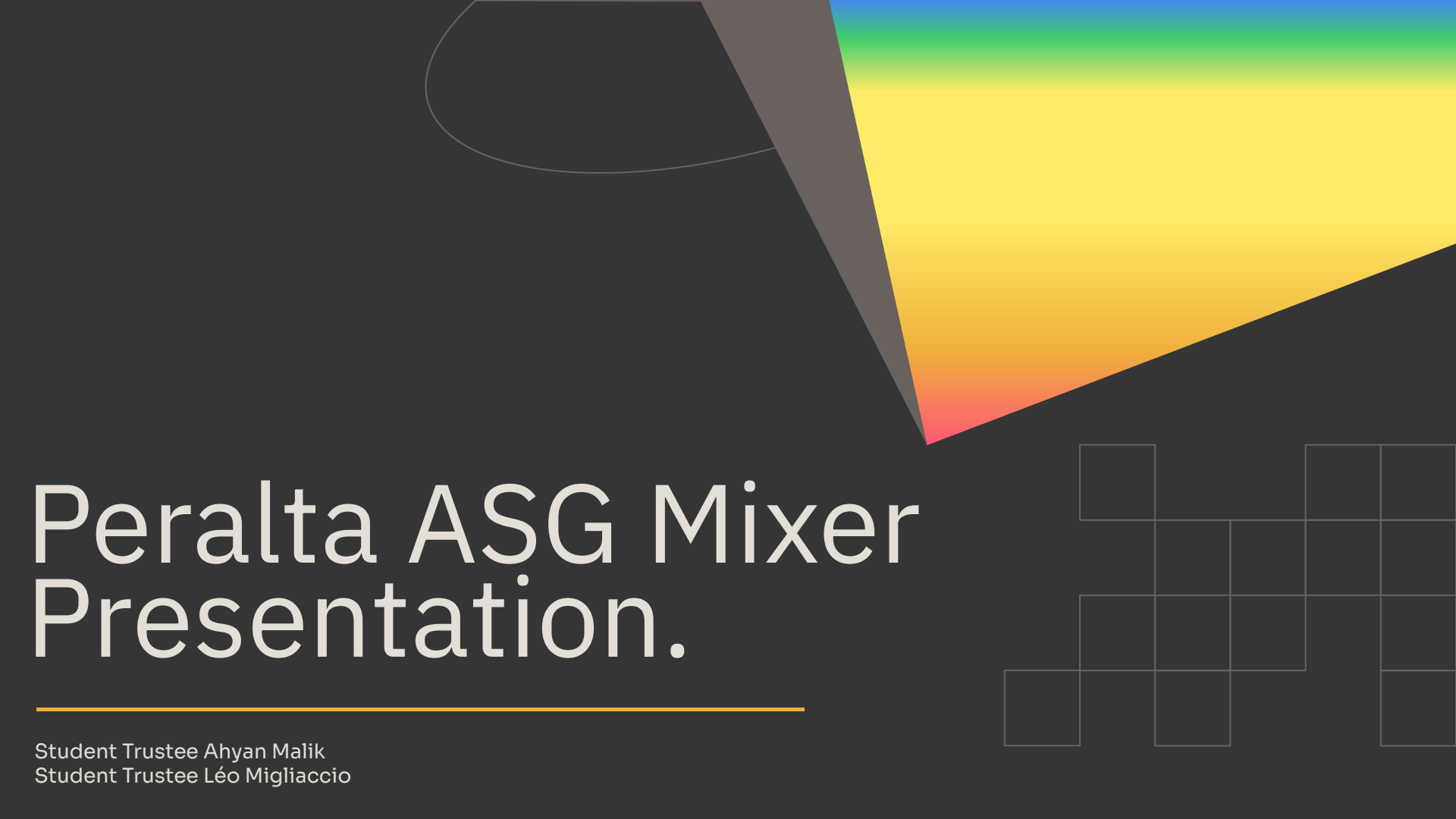

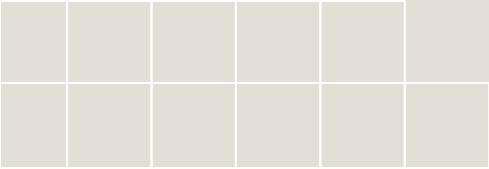

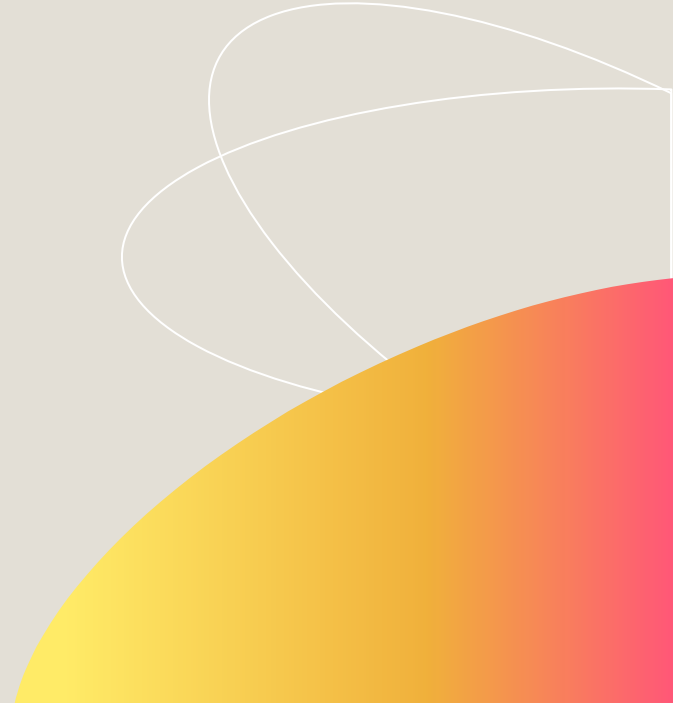
Why Does Shared Governance Matter?

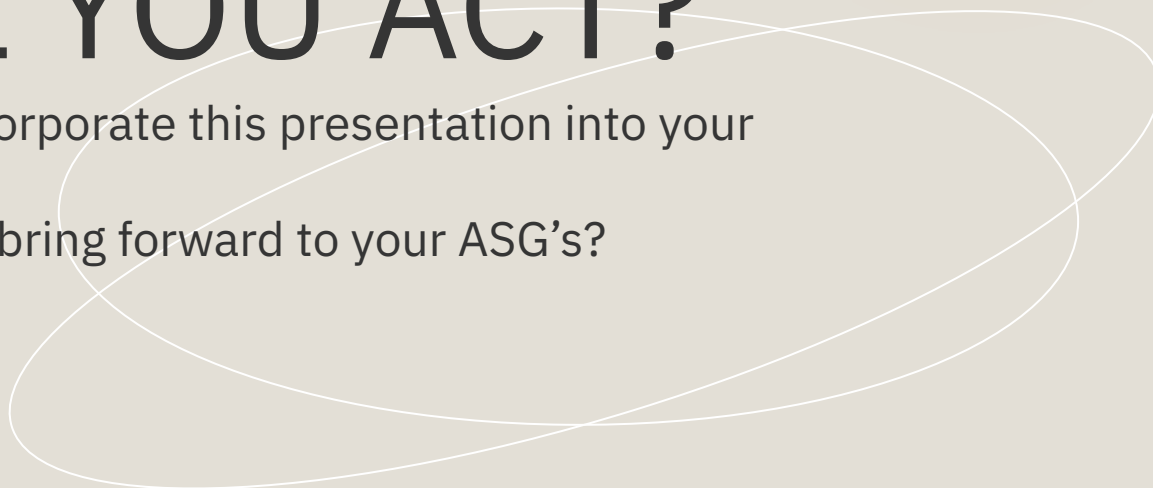

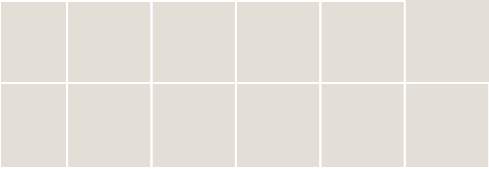
