Summer 2023 Enrollment

Summer 2023 is in full swing at Laney. The college is currently teaching 126 sections of classes, with a total of 3,041 students in them. This is 8% growth over the number of students who took summer classes last year. Classes are being taught in all academic divisions, from African American Studies through Wood Tech. Particularly exciting are the career education courses that are being taught as part of the CE Summer Institute. The Summer Institute is a collaboration with the Oakland Unified School District and is designed to give high school students a taste of college life and to let them explore potential careers. The courses in the Summer Institute are in cosmetology, culinary arts, wood technology, and carpentry.

Concurrent enrollment offers high school students college level instruction and opportunities to earn units toward their college degree and credits toward their high school diploma. Below are the steps to participate in the Laney College Summer Institute:

- 1. SPEAK TO YOUR HS COUNSELOR**
Your counselor will help to determine if the summer institute will help you make progress toward your educational and professional goals.
- 2. APPLY TO THE SUMMER INSTITUTE**
The summer institute is ideal for high school students grade 9th through 12th. Fill out the online interest form at Laney.edu/summer to reserve your spot.
*Incoming 9th graders may also participate.
- 3. COMPLETE THE ADMISSIONS APPLICATION**
Go to peralta.com, enter "Laney College" in the search bar to begin the application.

- 4. COMPLETE THE HIGH SCHOOL SPECIAL ENROLLMENT FORM**






