where education, sustainability, and opportunity will flourish together for generations to come.




The project is the culmination of committed and directed effort, so I want to take a moment to recognize the faculty—specifically Chris Grampp and Laura Forlin—

whose dedication and imagination many years ago first planted the seed for this project. Molly Sealund and Nia Hill also deserve special recognition for their contributions. To our District




